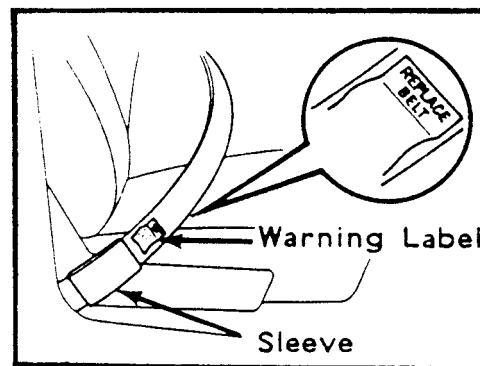

The following information provides guidelines for determining when occupant seat belts should be replaced following a traffic collision.

The entire seat belt assembly (both the buckle and the tongue ends) should be replaced if any of the following conditions exist:

- The seat belt was in use during a severe impact (even if no damage to the belt is obvious).
- The seat belt warning label under the anchor and sleeve is exposed.



NOTE: Not all Toyota vehicles are equipped with this type of warning label. Therefore, it may be necessary to replace the seat belt even when no label has been exposed.

NOTE: Toyota assumes no responsibility or liability for the replacement of seat belts and/or seat belt assemblies that were in use and subsequently damaged as the result of a traffic collision, accident, or other calamity.
