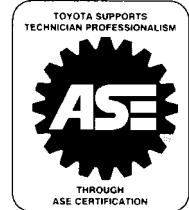

The black and color keyed bumper covers on 1987 and later Camrys may appear identical. However, the composition of these bumper covers is different, and therefore, these parts are not interchangeable:

NOTE:

* The standard and deluxe black bumper covers are not painted but contain chemicals to resist surface degradation due to sunlight. These chemicals also reduce paint adhesion if painting is attempted.

** The LE bumper covers must be painted because they do not contain the sunlight resistant chemicals found in the deluxe bumper covers.

*** 3-piece bumper design. The same precautions apply for the front piece as for the one piece bumper. The side bumper extensions for the front bumper are the same parts for STD, DLX an LE models. The side bumper extensions are a different material than the front piece and therefore may be left black for STD and DLX models or painted for LE models. The side bumper extensions for the rear bumper are different parts for the sedan and wagon, but the same for STD, DLX and LE models.
